Barcelona Regional is a 100% public company who develops the strategic urban projects for the Barcelona Town Council.

Among other projects, he was involved in the “El Calderí” scheme in Mollet del Vallès, which forms part of Metropolitan Barcelona’s second tier. The project covers a 30 hectare site and will provide 900 dwellings, a shopping and leisure centre, a hotel, public facilities, etc. (totalling 153,000 m2 of floor space). (2001- 2005).

He has worked in the Barcelona’s Regional team that developed the basic project of the high speed train station in La sagrera Barcelona (2005)

He has represented Barcelona Regional in different workshops and symposiums: Barcelona, Belgrade, Málaga, etc.

“Social and Urban Diagnosis of the Mina District” (1999). The Mina is a residential district built in the 1970s. It is sited in the town of Sant Adrià de Besòs and forms part of Metropolitan Barcelona’s first tier. The district, which has 3,000 dwellings and 10,000 inhabitants, suffers from severe urban blight and a host of social problems.

“Urban Renewal of the Districts in Southern Santa Coloma de Gramenet”. Urban renewal proposal for Santa Coloma de Gramenet, one of Barcelona’s most blighted areas. The district, which is home to 25,000 people, forms part of Metropolitan Barcelona’s first tier. (2001).

Mataró Town Council

Mataró is a town with a population of 100,000 in the Barcelona Metropolitan Region. Municipal architect specialising in urban planning themes (1984 - 1989).

He worked on the “Camí de la Serra” development, which involved building a new residential district comprising 800 dwelling of various types (flats and houses). He worked on the whole project from the planning stage through to the building work. The project included a 2-hectare urban park. (1989-1992)
